# Protecting its Past

## **Exmoor Trust**

The Exmoor Trust was registered as a charity in 1999. We support a broad range of issues relating to Greater Exmoor, its inhabitants, ecology and environment. Our aims and objectives are threefold:

- To conserve and enhance for the public benefit the area known as Greater Exmoor.
- To encourage the public to appreciate and respect all aspects of its historical, physical and cultural environment.
- To further such charitable purposes for the benefit of Exmoor as the Trustees shall determine from time to time.

The Greater Exmoor area covered by the Trust extends from Watchet to Combe Martin in the north, to South Molton and Clayhanger in the south, and includes Minehead.

The Trust achieves its objectives by raising, managing and disbursing funds, and using its influence and expertise to help, support and sustain the communities.

The Exmoor Trust is not a large organisation. Our income is derived from gifts, donations and membership fees, as well as invested income and we make on average annual grants of some £4,000. The contribution made is not always financial. The Trust is represented on a number of initiatives addressing key issues for Greater Exmoor. The Exmoor Trust has to date also organised three successful symposia on broadband and renewable energy.

## **Helping Exmoor to Help Itself**

### **Our Aim**

We seek to achieve, in a sustainable and enduring way, a happy balance of interests which will continue to provide vibrant community life, continued interest for the public, the preservation of the wildness of the environment and, above all, hope for the future.

### **We Need Local Help**

The Exmoor Trust needs to react to the emerging problems facing Greater Exmoor and welcomes the support and experience of people living in the area. We have groups that provide feedback and preliminary judgements to the Trustees on conservation, education and community issues. If you wish to help please do get in touch.

## **Grants**

As a charity the Trust cannot make grants to businesses but can help communities, organisations and individuals. Since its foundation the Exmoor Trust has typically provided immediate alleviation from the impact of Foot and Mouth disease to 62 families, given major support for the training and development of Young Farmers, assisted tourist organisations to revitalise their marketing and management and played a significant role in plans to improve the Moorland of Exmoor. In addition we have provided smaller grants for a number of school activities, play grounds, sensory garden projects, as well as for disadvantaged groups.

We are able to react promptly to calls for assistance. Whether you are a local individual, family, community or organisation needing help we would like to hear from you.
